President Report (Wallace)

Directors Report (Saldana / Davis)

- Region Band auditions 26 student made all district, region and 9th grade bands. This is 2 more than last year. There are 6 advancing to all area audition.
- Area Retreat There is an opportunity for a clinician workshop prior to audition, the second week of Christmas break. There is a possibility of location to be in Austin
- Mattress Fundraiser This is planned for March 3, 2019. Planning has begun with Mr. Marsh from the fundraising organization.

Upcoming Jazz Performances:

- Valentine Jazz Dance Last year we profited about \$2000, netting about \$1200 after giving \$800 to the middle school participants. Tickets were \$10 last year, but we may charge a bit more this year and do a little more food. Saturday February 9th is the tentative date. We will need a committee formed with 2 people on decorations and 2 people on food.
- Jazz on the Hill show Saturday May 4, 2019 is the tentative date. We will consider inviting another group (possibly Fulshear HS) and offer to feed their students. We are also considering bringing in a crawfish caterer and food trucks to make it a bigger event. Shade for the performance area should be considered. We will need a committee formed to start working on food.
- o Mr. Davis would like to meet with both committees before Christmas Break.
- Reflection on Marching Season Mr. Saldana recapped on marching season and initial thoughts for next year.
